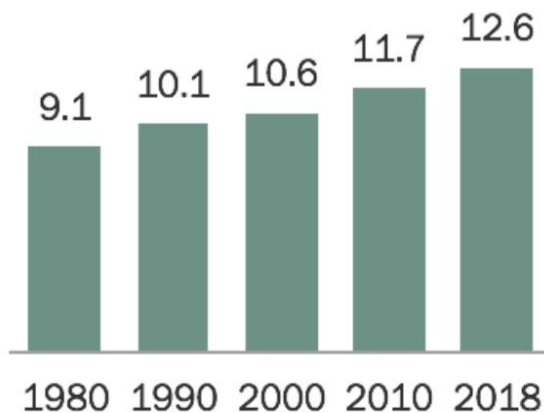

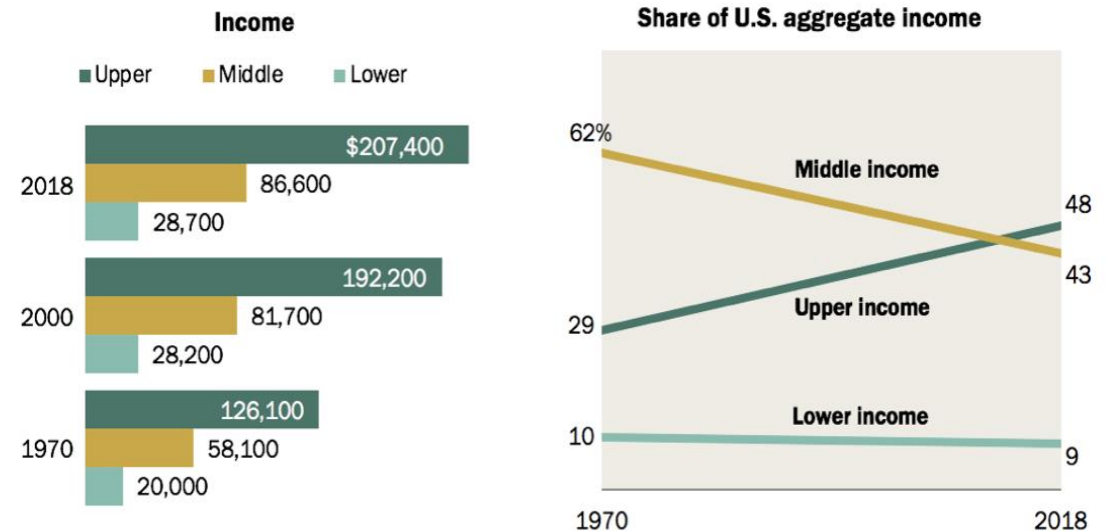
Income inequality in the U.S. is rising ...

Median household income, in 2018 dollars, and share of U.S. aggregate household income, by income tier



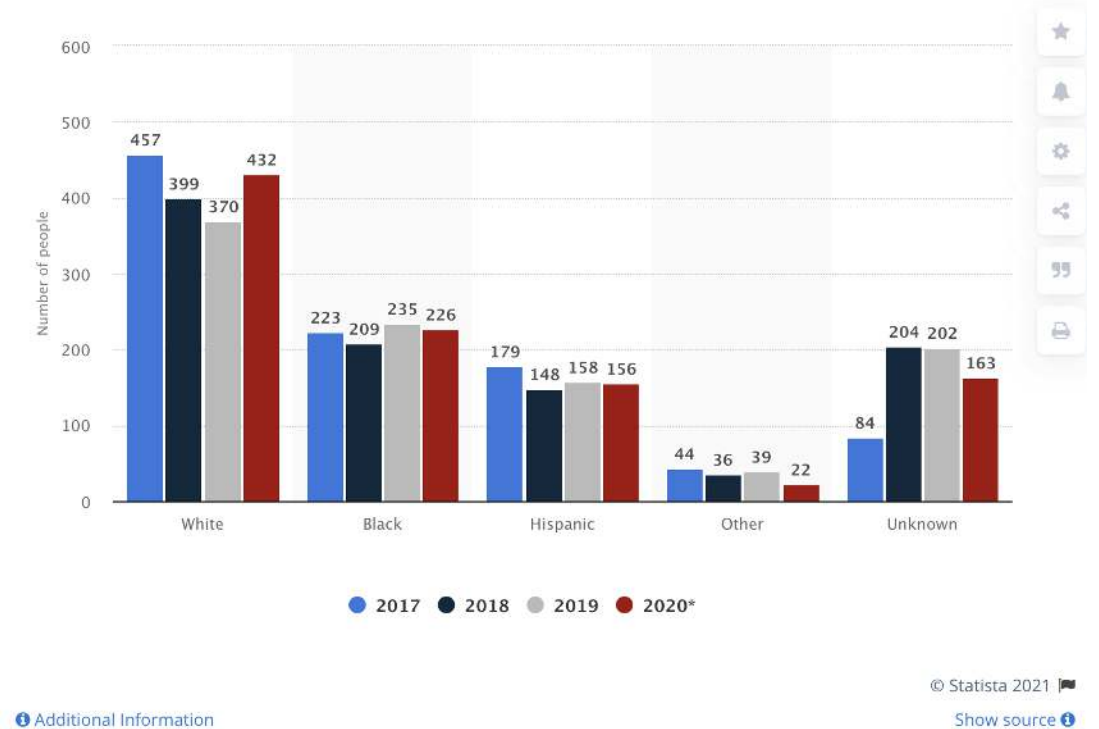
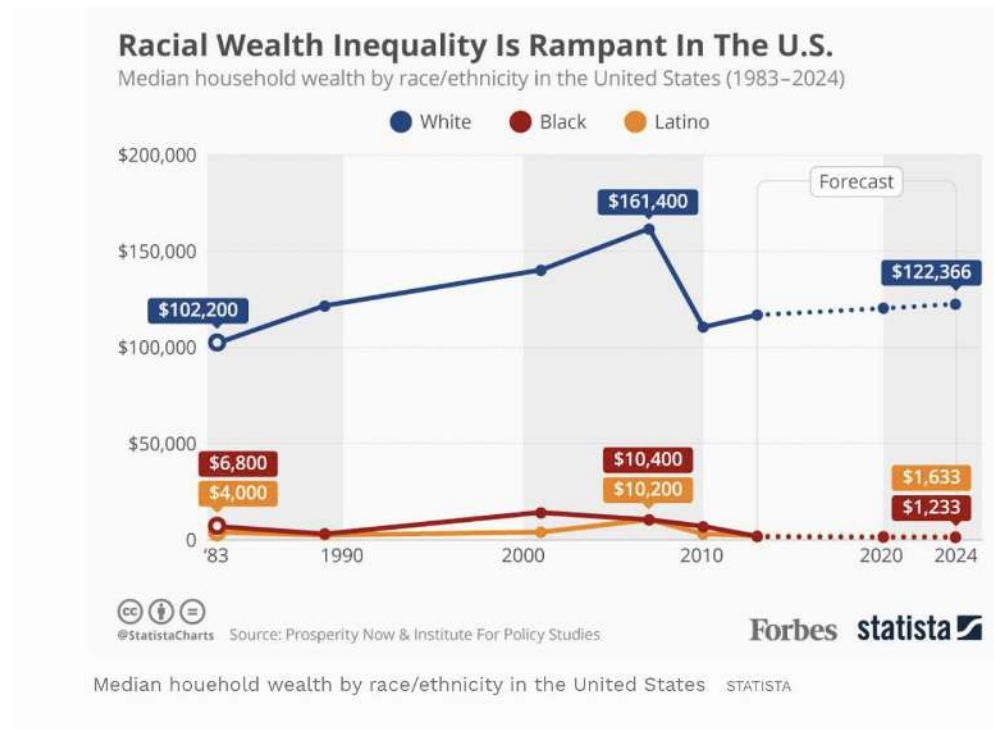

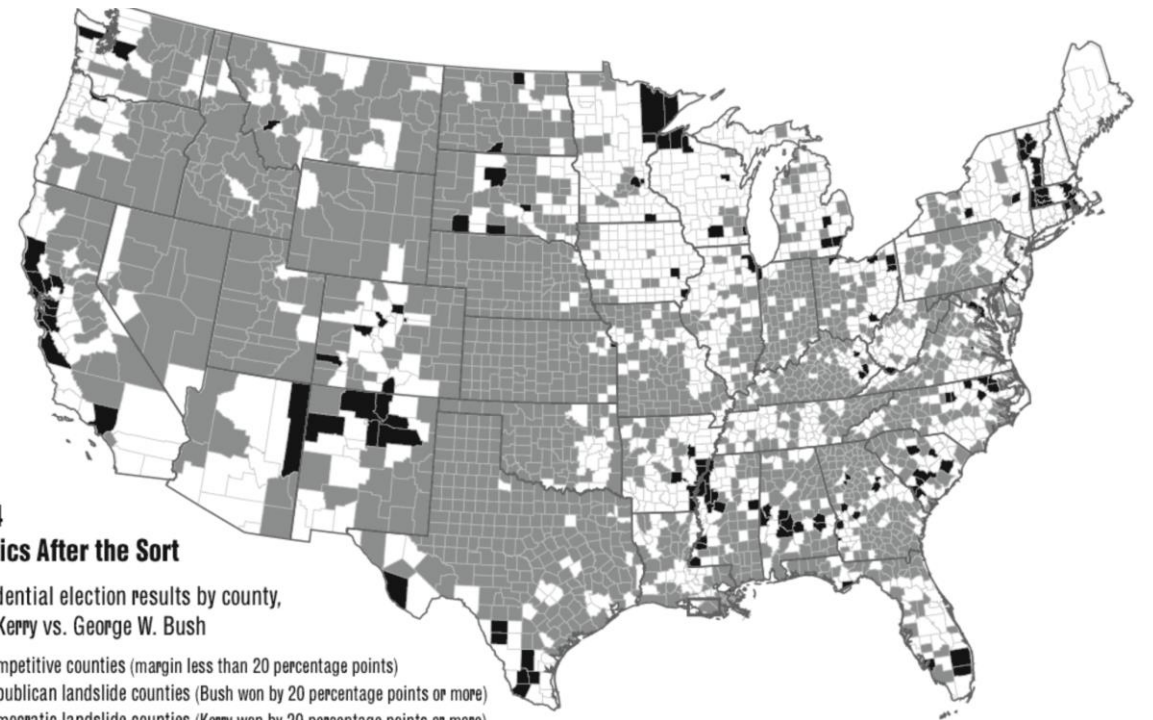

(Democratic and Republican votes only)



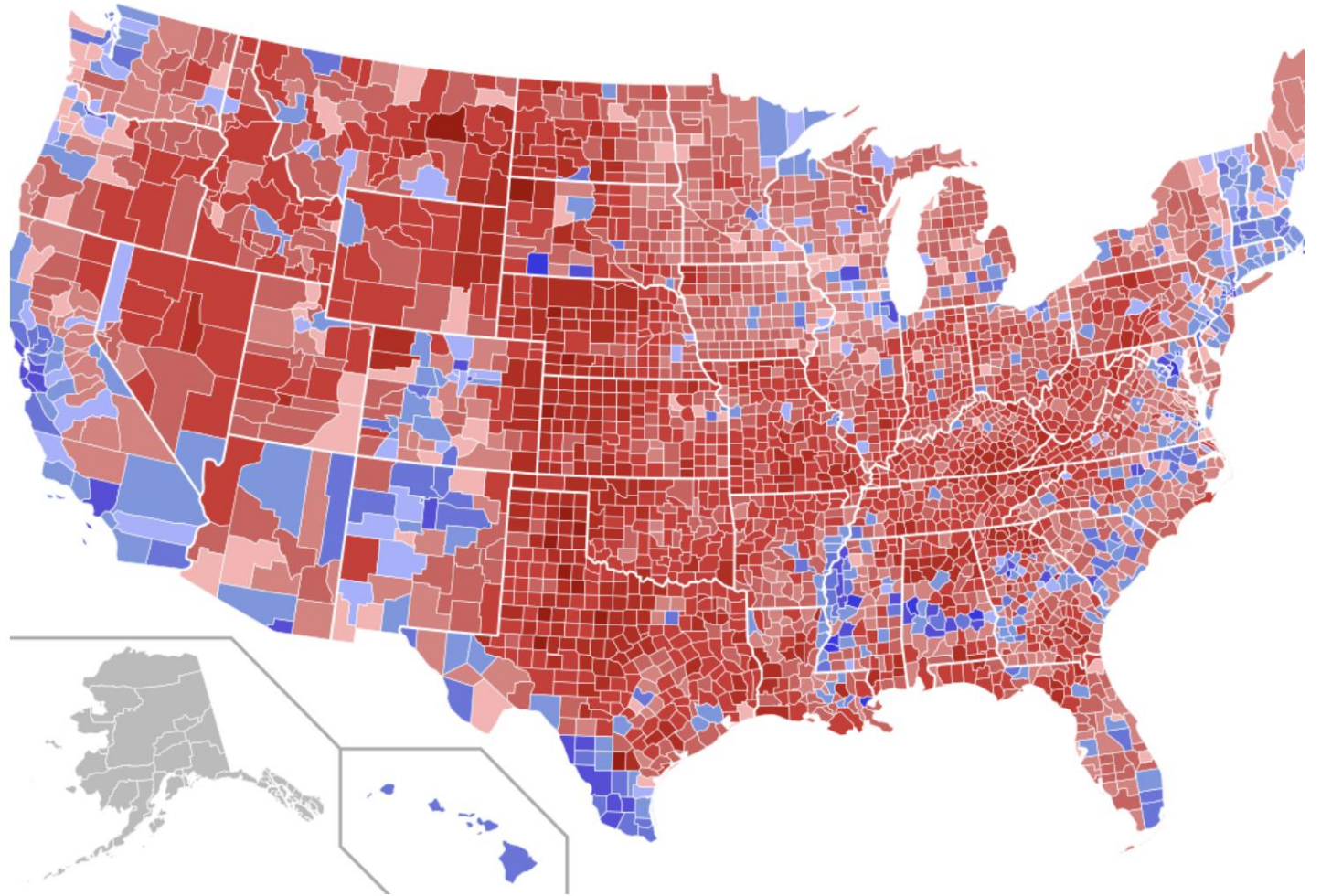

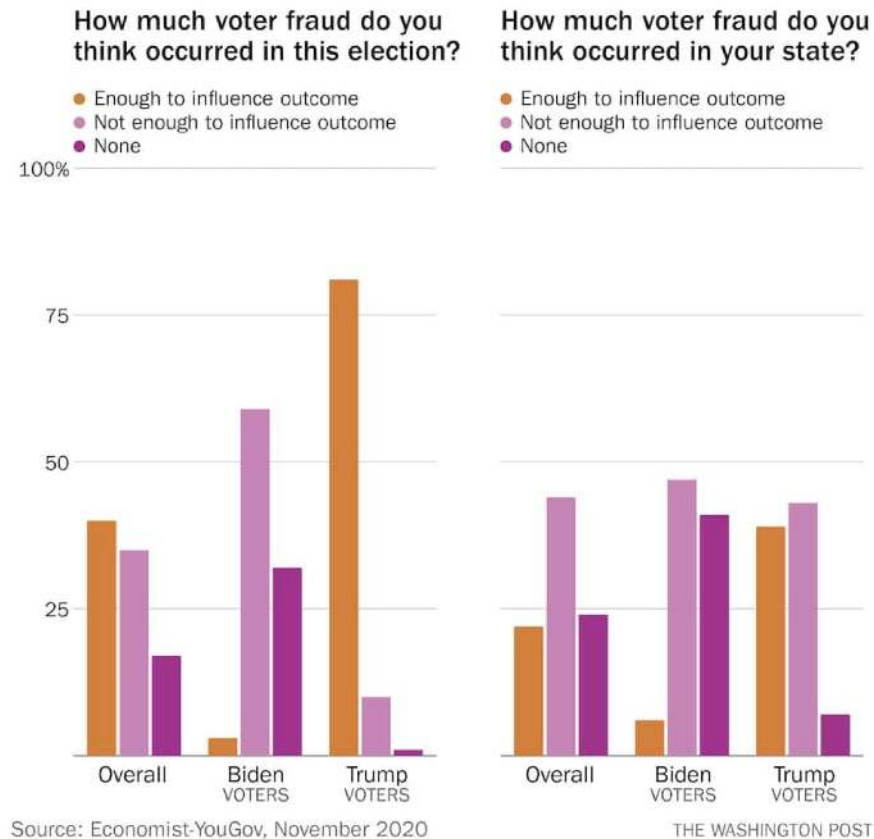
Presidential election results by county,

(Democratic and Republican votes only)

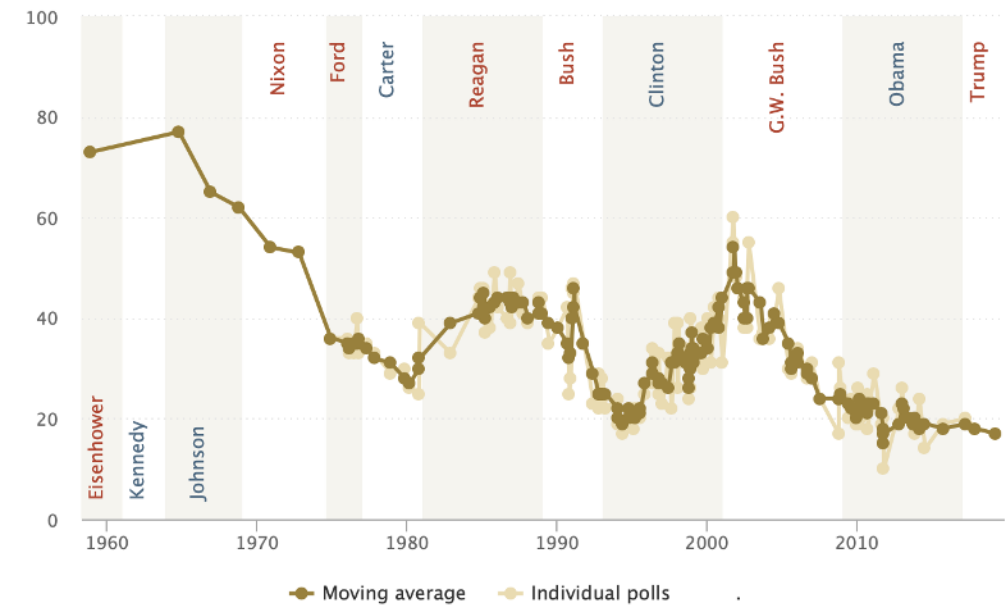

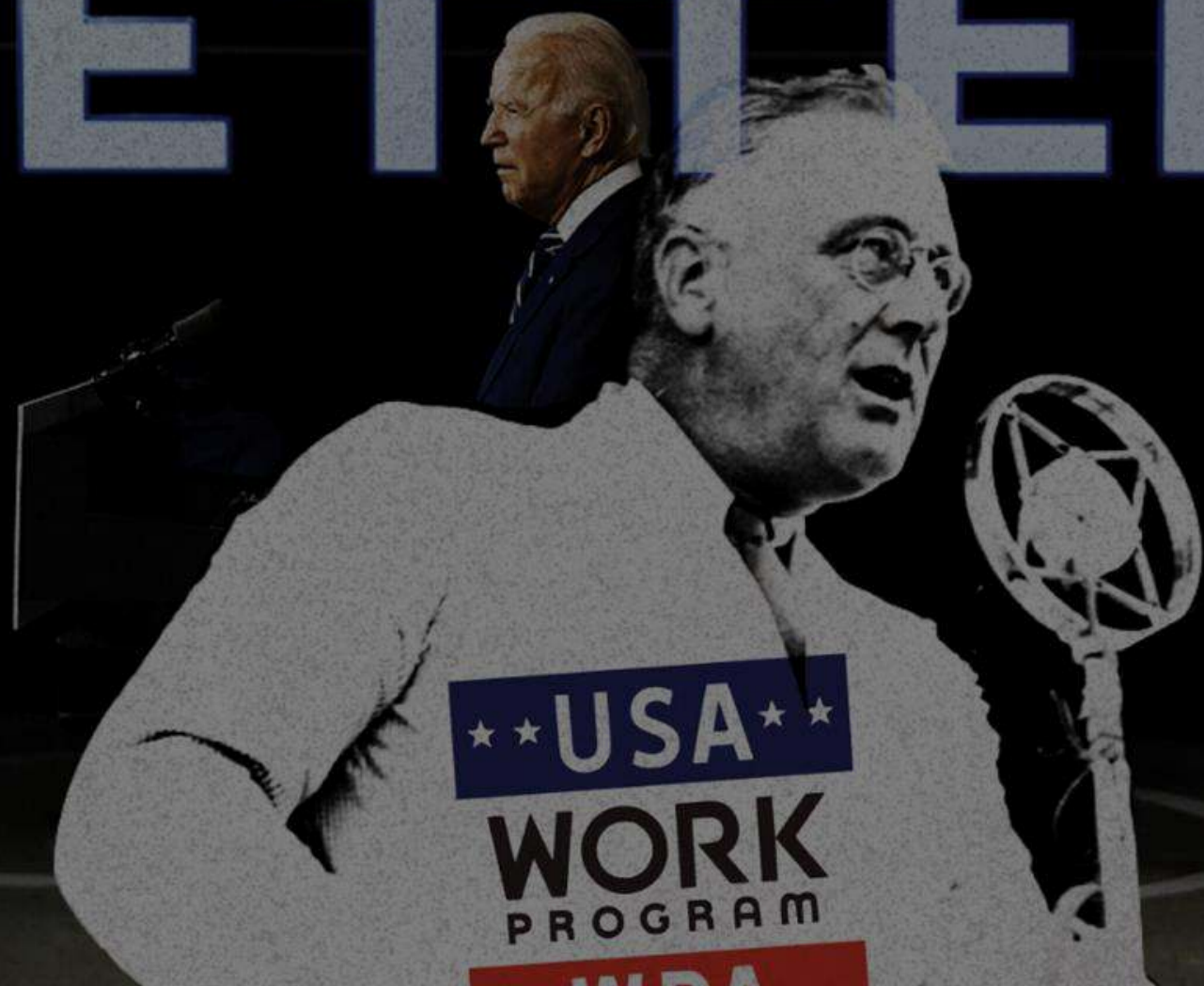

BUILD BACK BETTER



JULY 4, 1776.

We the People of the United States, in order to secure domestic Tranquillity, provide for the common defence, and our Posterity, do ordain and establish this Constitution for

Article I

Section 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.
Section 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.
No Person shall be a Representative who shall not have attained to the Age of twenty five Years, and seven Years a Citizen of the United States, who shall not, when elected, be an Inhabitant of that State in which he shall be chosen.
Representatives and direct Taxes shall be apportioned among the several States which may be included within the Union, according to their respective Numbers, which shall be determined by adding to the whole Number of free Persons, including those bound to Service for a Term of Years, three fifths of all other Persons. The actual Enumeration shall be made within three Years after the first Meeting of the Legislature, and within each subsequent Term of Years in such Manner as they shall by Law direct. The Number of Representatives shall not exceed one for every thirty Thousand Persons. The House of Representatives shall choose their Speaker and other Officers, and shall have the sole Power of Impeachment.
