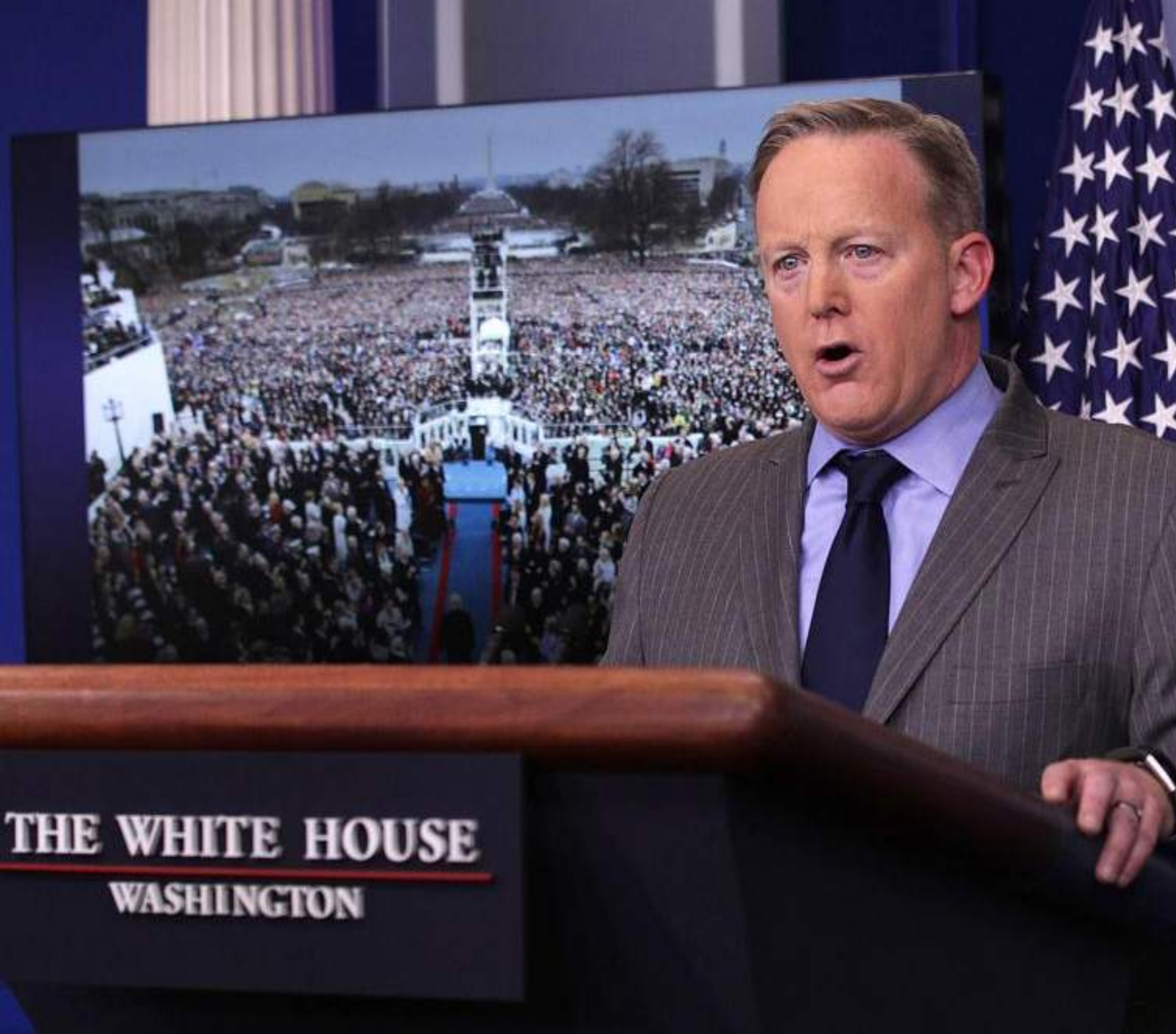

# President Trump made 16,241 false or misleading claims in his first three years

Three years after taking the oath of office, President Trump has made more than 16,200 false or misleading claims — a milestone that would have been unthinkable when we first created [the Fact Checker's database](#) that analyzes, categorizes and tracks every suspect statement he has uttered.

We started this project as part of our coverage of [the president's first 100 days](#), largely because we couldn't keep up with the pace and volume of the president's incoherence. We reported 45 of his most outrageous claims in the first five a day — and readers demanded that we keep it going for the rest of Trump's

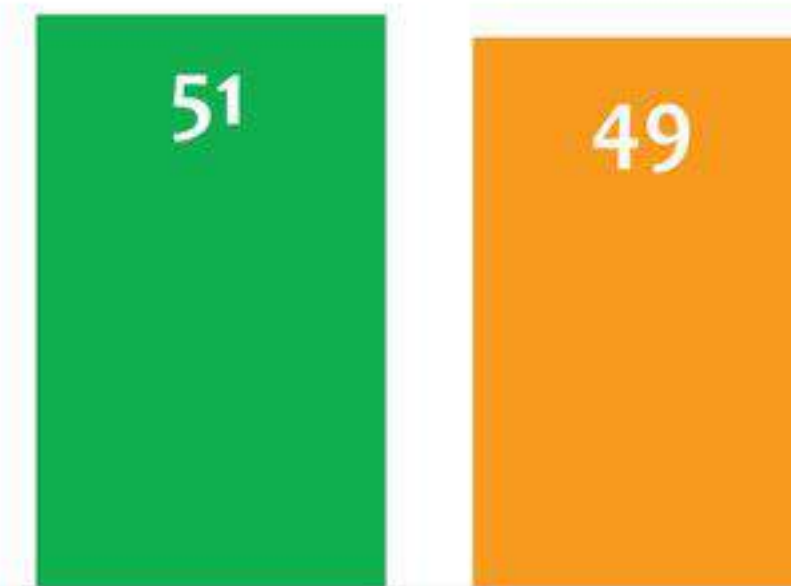
### Asked to Democrats

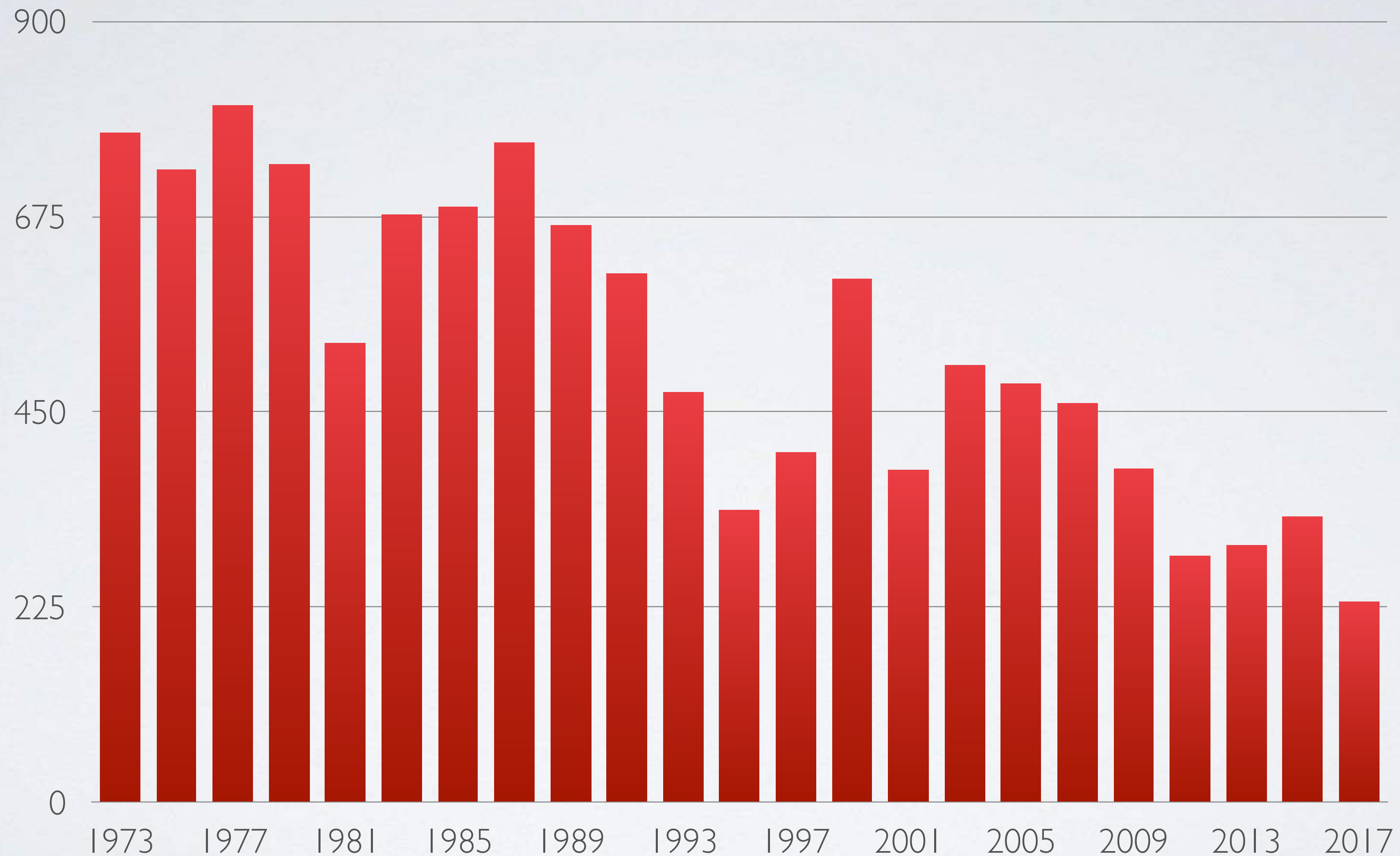

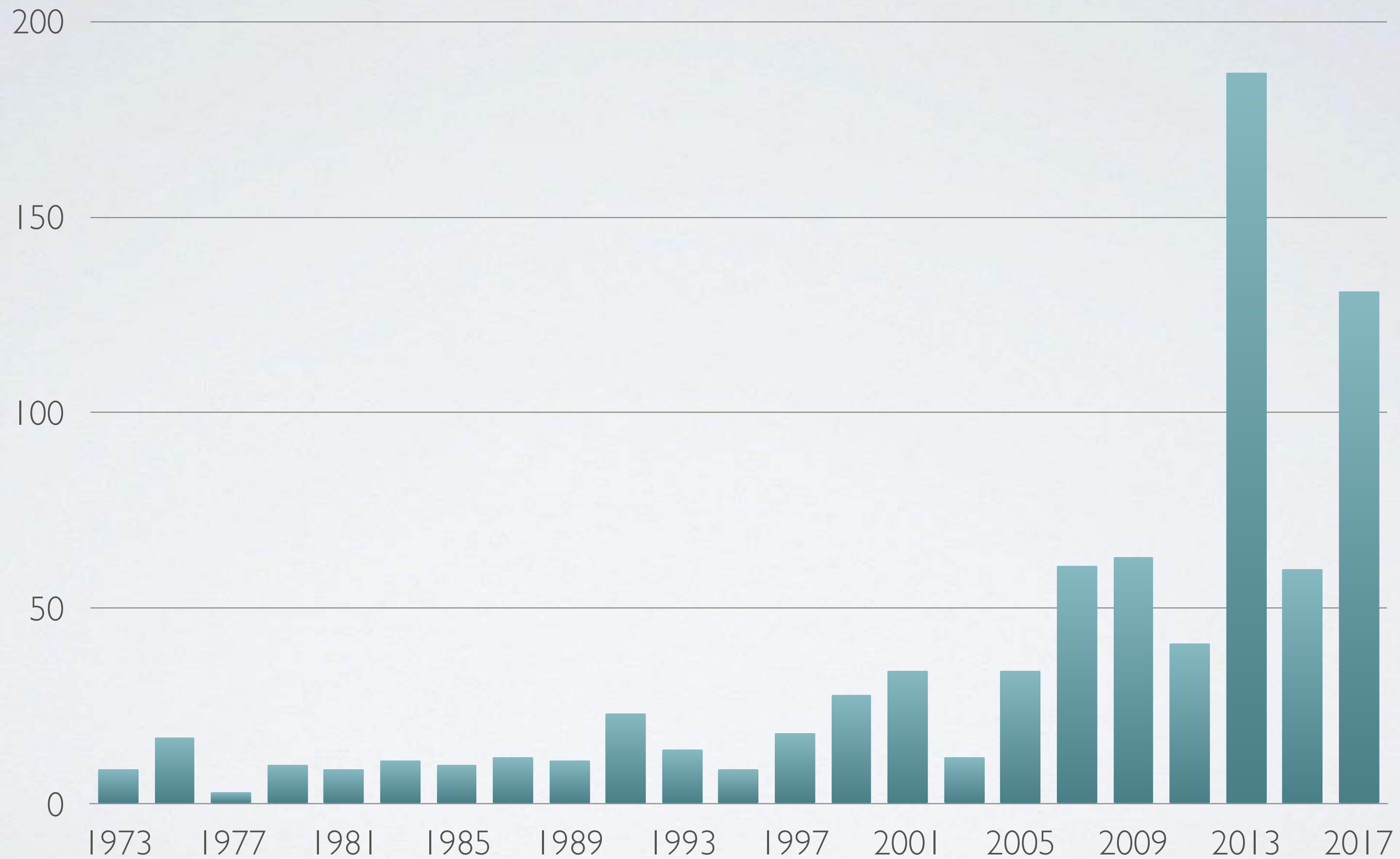

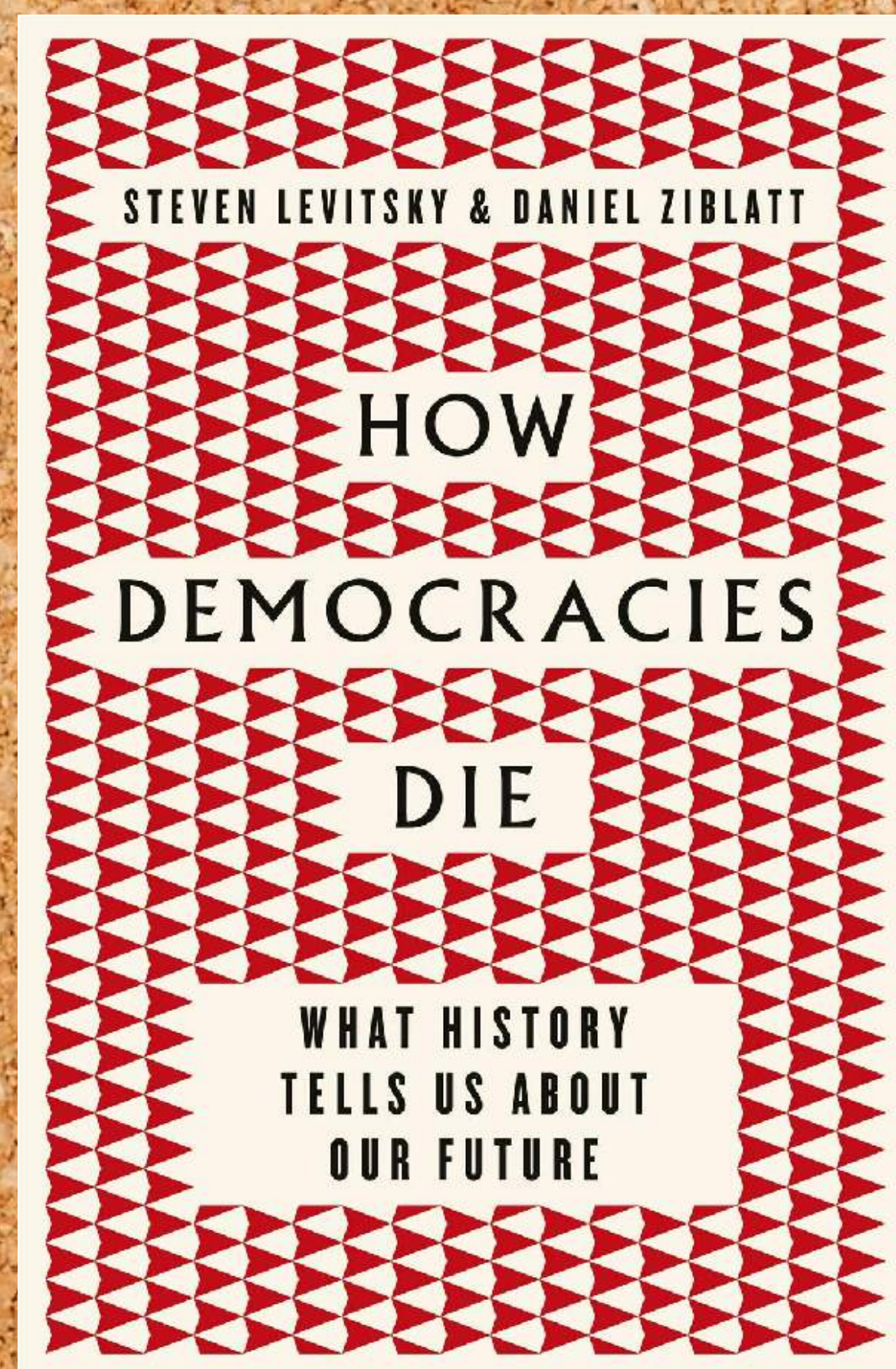

Roger Stone is an old friend of the president

**Four US prosecutors working on the case of Roger Stone - a convicted former advisor to US President Donald Trump - have quit.**

Their decision comes after the Justice Department said it planned to reduce the amount of prison time it would seek for the president's longtime ally.

Stone was found guilty on seven counts of lying to Congress, obstruction and witness tampering.

The prosecutors had recommended a sentence of seven to nine years.

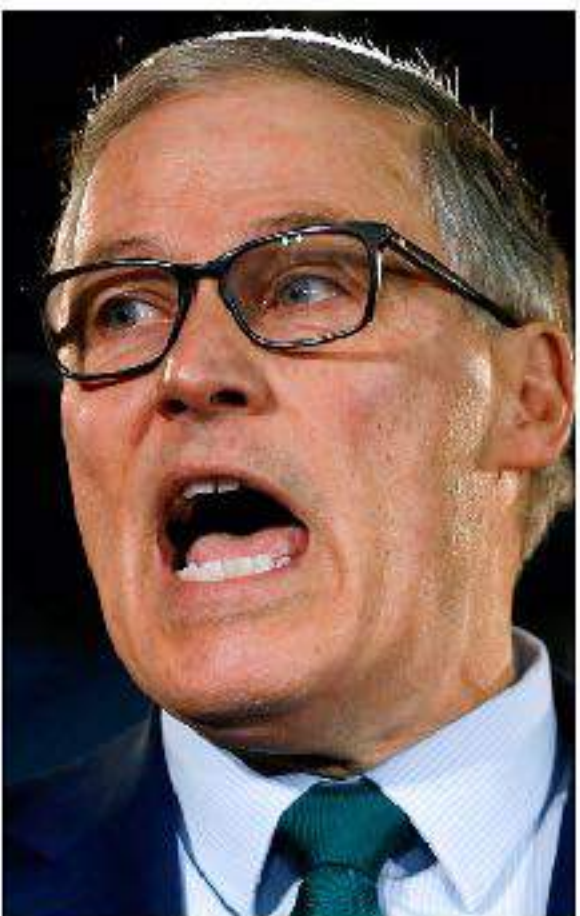
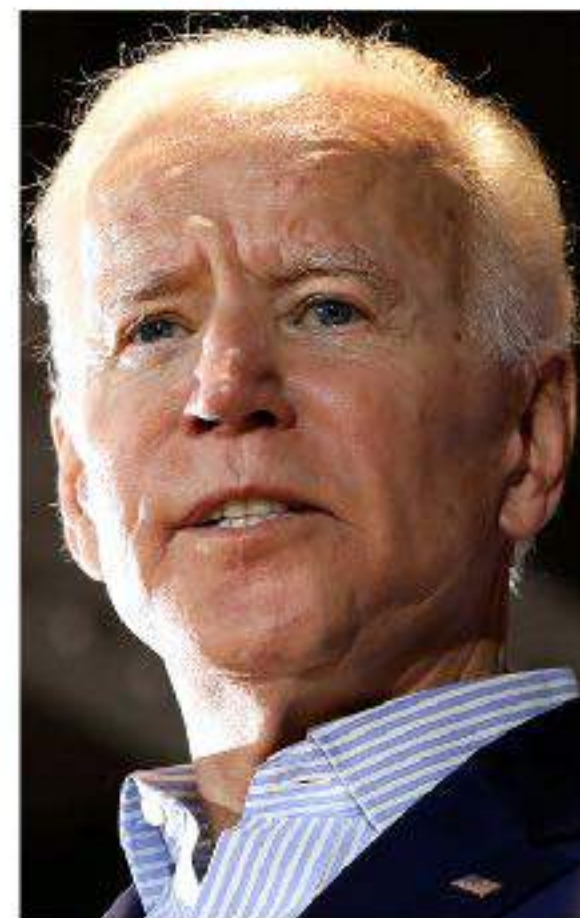
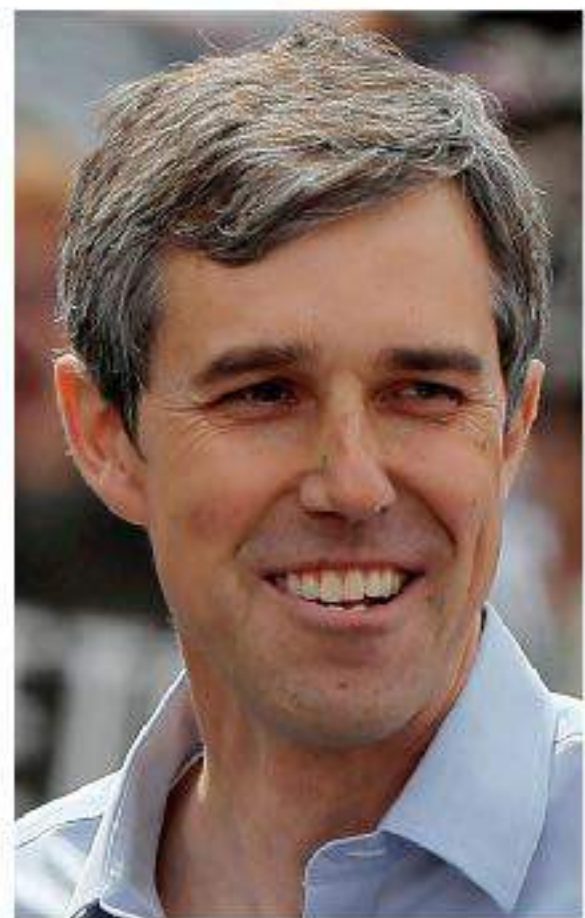

There are few talking points more beloved by underdog political candidates (and their aides) than to declare that money doesn't matter. (If it did, Steve Forbes would be the president!)

Well, they're wrong -- at least most of the time.

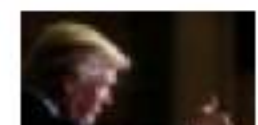

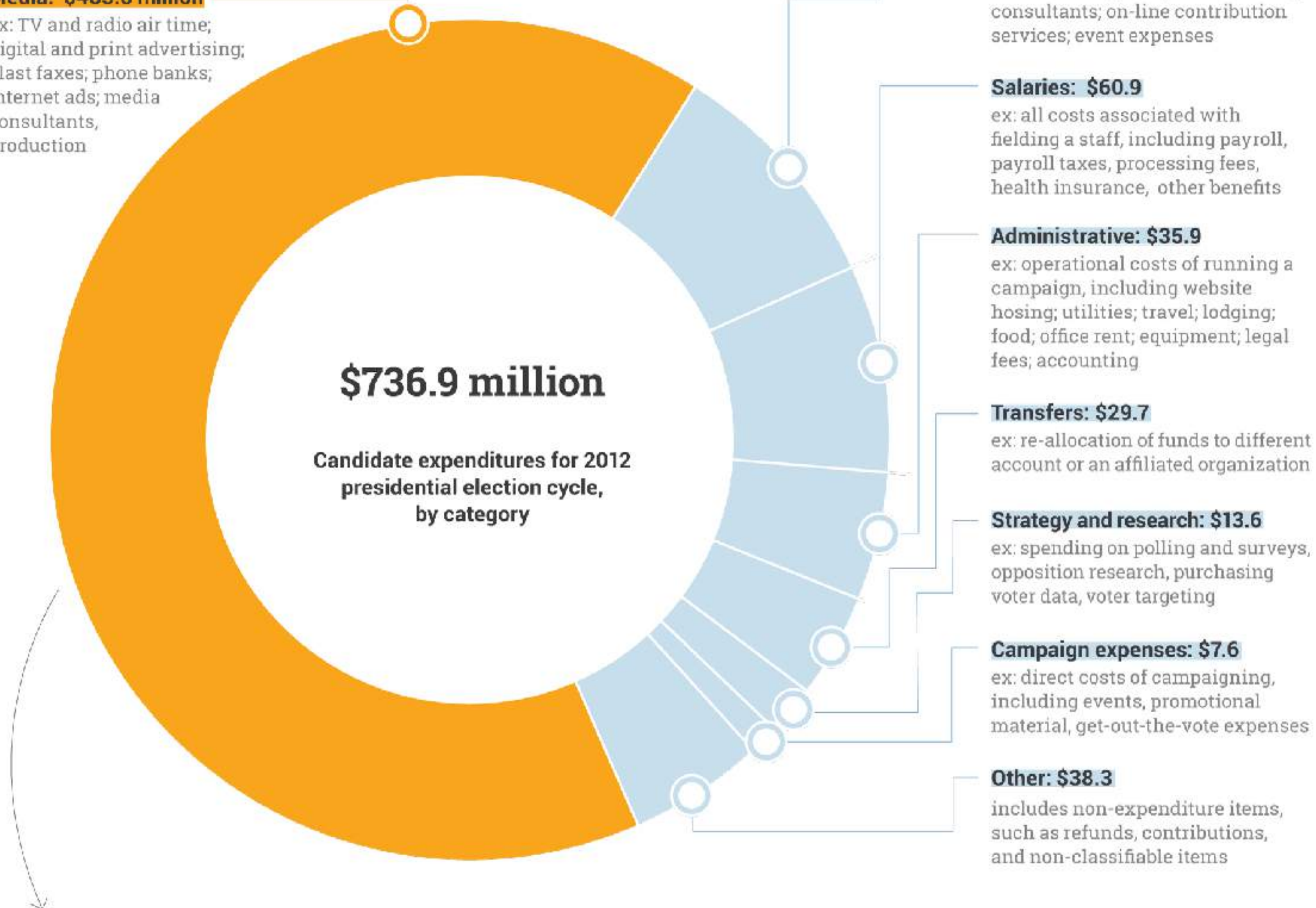




## OBAMA FOR AMERICA: 2012 Presidential Candidate Expenditures



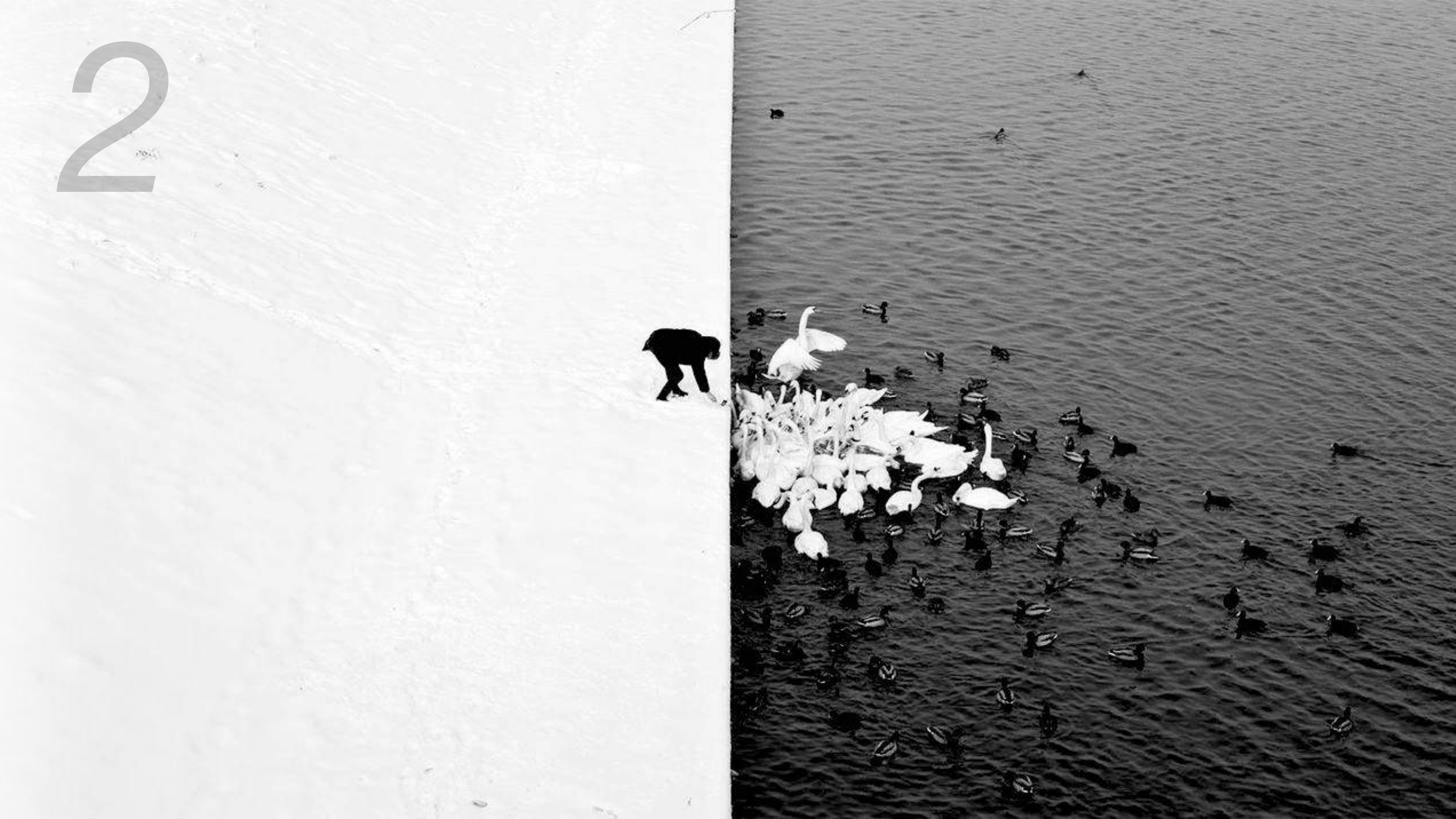

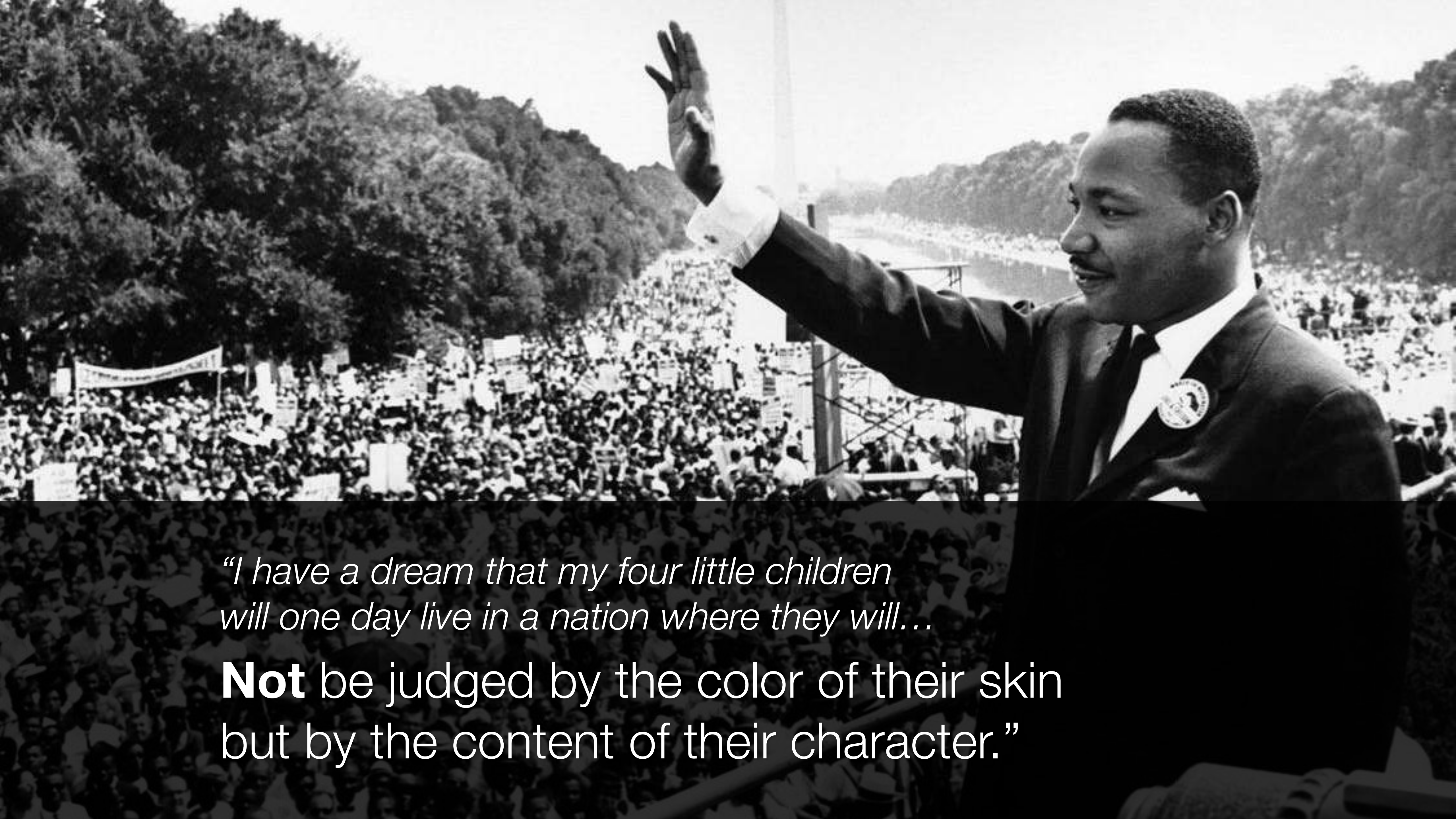
